Sign Up

Online at
healthpei.ca/RegistryUpdate
By phone (1-855-563-2101)
Or at Access PEI,
have your Health Card ready.
It takes about 15 minutes.

2

Wait for Confirmation

You'll get an email confirming you're on the list. You'll be contacted when a local doctor is accepting new patients.

3

Patient Matching

Patients are matched in the order they signed up. Those waiting longest in each region get matched first.

4

Meanwhile, Use Virtual Care

Within 2 weeks, you'll get an email to sign up for virtual care, where you can see a doctor online while you wait to get matched.

5

Keep Your Info Updated

You'll be emailed twice a year to remind you to update your details, so watch your inbox. You can also update your information by phone (1-855-563-2101), or at Access PEI.

6

When to Update Info

Update if you move, change household members, or switch regions.

7

What You'll Need

Have your Health Card (or Provincial Health Number) and birth date for each family member. Use the Registry Regions Map to check your assigned area.
