- 6 Conversion factors used for 1 bushel of apples from 1926 to 1964 equals 45.0 pounds, 1965 equals 44.5 pounds, 1966 equals 44.0 pounds, 1967 equals 43.5 pounds, 1968 equals 43.0 pounds, 1969 equals 42.5 pounds, from 1970 on equals 42.0 pounds.
- The value of the crop from 1984 onward is not comparable to previous years because of a change in reporting techniques for New Brunswick only.
 - As of April 27, 1983, revisions back to 1926 in British Columbia were carried out to reflect that 1 quart equals 1.25 pounds.
