REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION/INFORMATION GUIDE TO OBTAIN A DEALER TRADE LICENSE

1. Municipal Approval for Commercial Business Location

Permission in the form of a permit or letter must be obtained from the council of the city, town, or rural municipality to operate a place of business.

Please provide a copy of your permit or letter with your dealer trade license application. Contact Housing, Land and Communities if you have any questions about how to obtain Commercial Business approval.

2. Entry onto Arterial Highway Approval

If a place of business will be using an entranceway onto an arterial highway, you must contact Transportation and Infrastructure for approval. Please provide a copy of your approval with your dealer trade license application.

- **3. Register your Business Name** with the Department of Justice and Public Safety: Contact 902-368-4550 or register online at https://ocbr.princeedwardisland.ca/ocbr/login
- **4. Apply for HST Number:** Application to be made with Canada Revenue Agency to register for an HST number. Please provide your HST Number with your dealer trade license application. - **5. Apply for Environment Tax Number**: 902-368-4070 or online at https://www.princeedwardisland.ca/en/service/register-for-and-submit-online-environment-tax-return

6. Security Bond

Applicants are required to submit a security bond in the amount of \$15,000.00 which is to be in the format contained in the Schedule Form 1 (Dealer Trade License Regulations) and is available from most insurance companies for a yearly premium. After being duly signed and witnessed, the bond is to be forwarded to:

7. Repair and Inspection Facility

If the applicant does not have an inspection station on site, a written statement from an inspection station operator is to be returned with the application stating that they will do necessary repairs and inspections for the dealership.

Next Steps:

- After the application is completed and all copies of documents are provided, the applicant can then ready the place of business.
 - $\circ \quad \hbox{Office: To be situated at the business location where the vehicles are displayed.}$
 - o Signage: Must be sufficient to advertise and identify the vehicle dealership.
- When business premises are ready, contact the office of Highway Safety at 902-432-2714 or 902-888-8264. Highway Safety will send an Officer to visit your dealership location to conduct a site inspection.
- Approval from the Registrar of Motor Vehicles is required prior to dealer trade license being issued.
