- (B) AS PER THE PEI FISHERIES ACT REGULATIONS, SECTION 1 (i) "PRIMARY PROCESSING" MEANS CLEANING, FILLETING, SPLITTING, EXTRACTING, DIVIDING INTO PORTIONS, SALTING, ICING, FREEZING, COOKING, PICKLING, DRYING, CANNING, BOTTLING OR REDUCING FISH. PRIMARY PROCESSING LICENSE INCLUDES SECONDARY PROCESSING.
- (C) AS PER THEPEI FISHERIES ACTREGULATIONS, SECTION 1(I) "SECONDARY PROCESSING" MEANS ANY PROCESSING STAGE BEYOND PRIMARY PROCESSING, WHEREBY, FURTHER VALUE IS ADDED TO A FISH PRODUCT THROUGH PREPARATION INTO A CONSUMER PACK.
- (D) AS PER THEPEI FISHERIES ACTREGULATIONS SECTION 1(f) "LOBSTER COOK ROOM" MEANS A **BUILDING OR** PORTION OF A BUILDING OPERATED IN CONJUCTION WITH A LOBSTER POUND, USED FOR COOKING LOBSTER MAXIMUM SIZE 144 SQ.FT.
- (E) LICENSE FEES CAN BE PAID BY CASH, CHEQUE OR MONEY ORDER (SECTION 9(3) AND SCHEDULE 6 OF THE PEI FISHERIES ACT REGULATIONS). IF APPLYING ONLINE, PAY BY CREDIT CARD.
- (F) AS PER THE PEI FISHERIES ACT REGULATIONS, SECTION 4(5.1), A "GROUNDFISH PROCESSING ROOM" MEANS A PROCESSING ROOM OR AREA IN A PROCESSING FACILITY THAT DOES NOT EXCEED 750 SQ. FT.
- (G) FISH THAT IS INTENDED FOR PROCESSING SHALL BE ADEQUATELY ICED OR CHILLED WHILE BEING HELD OR TRANSPORTED AND SHALL BE PROTECTED FROM CONTAMINATION AND THE WEATHER.
