

## Application for Non-Domestic Pesticide Vendor Certificate

Under section 31 of the *Pesticide Control Act* Regulations, a person who sells non-domestic pesticides or Schedule 1 pesticides to another person or, while acting as an employee of a business that is licensed to sell non-domestic pesticides, provides pesticide related information or recommendations to another person, must hold a Non-Domestic Pesticide Vendor Certificate.

Personal information on this form is collected under section 14 of the *Pesticide Control Act* Regulations as it relates directly to and is necessary for an application for a Non-Domestic Pesticide Vendor Certificate. Personal information may be disclosed to third parties in accordance with provincial legislation.
