- All courses being submitted for consideration must have proof of marks. Please provide a copy of you high school transcript.
- ENR (Enrolled), Modified (MOD), Individualized (IND), Intervention (INT) courses are not acceptable.
- Courses that have been retired or names have changed may be considered on a case-by-case basis.
- High school courses from other province, territories or countries will not be considered.
- It is the sole responsibility of the individual requesting PLAR to provide complete, valid and original documentation as requested.

Note: All decisions to grant PLAR are at the discretion of the PEI CAEC Administrator, based on the provision of appropriate documentation & completion of a PLAR request form. Please note a response will be given in 5 business days after your submission
