MUNICIPALITIES ACT Chapter M-13

REGULATIONS

Pursuant to section 67 of the *Municipalities Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. M-13, Council made the following regulations:

1. Prescribed amount

For the purposes of subsection 27(4) of the Act the amount prescribed is \$50,000. (EC252/84; 18/92)

The form of the oath of office to be taken by the returning officer or deputy returning officer pursuant to subsection (21) of Schedule 2 of the Act is set out in Form 5 of the Schedule. (EC252/84)

The form of the oath of office to be taken by a poll clerk pursuant to subsection (22) of Schedule 2 of the Act is set out in Form 6 of the Schedule. (EC252/84)

The form of declaration by an elector whose name is not entered on the list of electors pursuant to subsection (24) of Schedule 2 of the Act is set out in Form 7 of the Schedule. (EC252/84)

The form of the oath to be taken by a challenged elector pursuant to subsection 48(5) of the Act and subsection (26) of Schedule 2 of the Act is set out in Form 8 of the Schedule. (EC252/84; 356/93)

The form of the oath to be taken by an agent of a candidate pursuant to subsection (30) of Schedule 2 of the Act is set out in Form 9 of the Schedule. (EC252/84)

The form of oath to be taken by an impersonated elector pursuant to subsection (39) of Schedule 2 of the Act is set out in Form 9.1 of the Schedule. (EC356/93)
