FIELD INVESTIGATOR QUALIFICATIONS REGULATIONS

Pursuant to section 56 of the *Coroners Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. C-25.1, Council made the following regulations:

1. Qualifications for field investigator

In order to be considered for appointment as a field investigator under the *Coroners Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. C-25.1, a person must have successfully completed

- (a) a nursing education program;
- (b) a medical degree program; or
- (c) training in emergency medical services. (EC616/19)
