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CHAPTER D-13.11

DOWN SYNDROME DAY ACT

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS Down syndrome is a naturally occurring chromosomal arrangement that has always been a part of the human condition, exists in all regions across the globe and commonly results in variable effects on learning styles, physical characteristics or health;

AND WHEREAS the inherent dignity, worth and valuable contributions of persons with intellectual disabilities should be recognized as promoters of the well-being and diversity of their communities, and the importance of their individual autonomy and independence, including the freedom to make their own choices;

AND WHEREAS it is important to take measures to raise awareness throughout society, including at the family level, regarding persons with Down syndrome;

THEREFORE it is appropriate to establish a day to promote awareness about Down syndrome.

1. Down Syndrome Awareness Day, March 21st

March 21st in each year is proclaimed as Down Syndrome Awareness Day in Prince Edward Island. 2020,c.88,s.1.
