2. In addition to the eligibility criteria or requirements for certification Additional required under subsection 7(3) of the Act, in order to be eligible for certification certification, a fisheries organization shall satisfy the Minister that the fisheries organization

- (a) has membership in each of the three counties in the province; and
- (b) has, as members at the time the fisheries organization applies for certification, at least 20% of the total number of persons who are fishers.
- 3. A certified fisheries organization shall issue any necessary receipts to Issuance of receipts fishers for moneys received under the Act or these regulations.
- **4.** These regulations come into force on July 31, 2004.

Commencement

EXPLANATORY NOTES

SECTION 1 prescribes the annual support fee that fishers must pay to the Minister.

SECTION 2 establishes additional certification requirements for fisheries organizations.

SECTION 3 requires certified fisheries organizations to issue receipts for moneys received under the Act or these regulations.

SECTION 4 provides for the commencement of these regulations.
