WILDLIFE CONSERVATION ACT FUR HARVESTING REGULATIONS **AMENDMENT**

Pursuant to section 28 of the Wildlife Conservation Act R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. W-4.1, Council made the following regulations:

1. Section 2 of the Wildlife Conservation Act Fur Harvesting Regulations (EC663/04) is amended

- (a) by the revocation of subclause (1)(a)(i) and the substitution of the following:
 - (i) was the holder of a valid trapping license within the previous five years from the date of application, or
- (b) by the addition of the following after subsection (3):
- (3.1) Where an applicant for a trapping license was a previous holder Previous holder of of a valid trapping license but not within the five years preceding the date trapping license of application, the applicant shall

- (a) successfully complete a trapper education program approved by the Minister: and
- (b) pay the prescribed fee set out in Schedule B, prior to being issued a trapping license by the Minister, unless the Minister exempts the applicant from this subsection.
- 2. Section 4 of the regulations is amended by the addition of the following after subsection (5):
- (6) No person shall set a snare designated to catch red fox or coyote Offence within the right-of-way of a highway.
- 3. Section 5 of the regulations is amended by the addition of the following after subsection (5):
- (6) No person shall use a body-gripping trap to take a beaver, raccoon Body-gripping trap or muskrat on land unless the body-gripping trap is an approved bodygripping trap listed in Schedule C.
- (7) No person shall use a body-gripping trap to take a beaver or Idem muskrat underwater unless
 - (a) the body-gripping trap is an approved body-gripping trap listed in Schedule C; or
 - (b) the trap is set for muskrat and prevents the muskrat from resurfacing.

4. Section 9 of the regulations is amended

- (a) by the revocation of clause (1)(f) and the substitution of the following:
- (f) set a snare designed to kill red fox or coyote without examining each snare at least once every 48 hours;
- (b) in clause (1)(i), by the deletion of the word "or" after the semicolon:
- (c) in clause (1)(j), by the deletion of the period and the substitution of the words "; or"; and
- (d) by the addition of the following after clause (1)(j):
- (k) set a body-gripping trap listed in Schedule C, a submarine trap or an underwater snare for beaver without examining each trap at least once every 72 hours.
- 5. The regulations are amended by the addition of Schedule C as set out in the Schedule to these regulations after Schedule B.
- 6. These regulations come into force on September 29, 2007.

SECTION 5 adds a Schedule to the regulations.

SECTION 6 provides for the commencement of these regulations.
