## ELEVATORS AND LIFTS ACT REGULATIONS AMENDMENT

Pursuant to subsection 17(1) of the *Elevators and Lifts Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. E-5, Council made the following regulations:

- 1. Section 2 of the *Elevators and Lifts Act* Regulations (EC469/71) is amended by the addition of the following after subsection (4):
- (5) Except as otherwise provided in these regulations, the standards *Idem* governing the design, manufacture, construction, installation, operation, inspection and testing of elevating platforms in wind turbines shall be those set forth in the CSA Standard CAN/CSA-Z271-98.
- 2. These regulations come into force on May 9, 2009.

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTES**

**SECTION 1** adopts the Canadian Standards Association (CSA) Safety Code governing the design, manufacture, construction, installation, operation, inspection and testing of elevating platforms in wind turbines.

**SECTION 2** provides for the commencement of these regulations.
