FINANCIAL ADMINSTRATION ACT SIGNING AUTHORITY DESIGNATIONS SECURITIES ISSUANCE INVESTING AND CASH MANAGEMENT BANKING RELATED SERVICES APPROVED

Pursuant to sections 14 and 54 of the *Financial Administration Act* R.S.P.E.I 1988, Cap. SOCIAL ASSISTANCE ACT ESTABLISHED RATES OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE (APPROVED)

Under authority of section 4.1 of the *Social Assistance Act*, R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. S-4.3, Council approved an increase in the established rate for personal comfort allowance from \$53.00 per month to \$71.00 per month, effective April 1, 2015.
