#### REGULATIONS AMENDMENT

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTES**

**SECTION 1** revokes section 5 of the *Finance PEI Act* Regulations. That section purported to give the power to approve the write-off of debts to the board. However, the power to authorize the write-off of debts is given to the Lieutenant Governor in Council by section 26.1 of the *Financial Administration Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. F-9.

**SECTION 2** provides for the commencement of the regulations.
