LIQUOR CONTROL ACT

REGULATIONS **AMENDMENT**

Made by the Prince Edward Island Liquor Control Commission and approved by the Lieutenant Governor in Council under the Liquor Control Act R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. L-14:

- 1. Section 91 of the Liquor Control Act Regulations (EC740/75) is amended by the addition of the following after subsection (5):
- (6) The Commission and the following persons may convey and Delivery of deliver unopened liquor purchased from the Commission or from a unopened liquor license holder referred to in clause (a) to a purchaser:
 - (a) the holder of a winery license, distiller's license or microbrewery license;
 - (b) a person acting on behalf of the Commission or a license holder referred to in clause (a).
- 2. Subsection 91(6) of the regulations is revoked on August 31, 2020.
- 3. These regulations come into force on March 21, 2020.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

SECTION 1 amends the Liquor Control Act Regulations to add a new subsection 91(6) that permits the Commission or a specified license holder or person to convey and deliver unopened liquor purchased from the Commission or the license holder to a purchaser.

SECTION 2 provides that the new subsection 91(6) is revoked on August 31, 2020.

SECTION 3 provides for the commencement of the regulations.
