E-12 Council authorized the Minister of Justice and Public Safety to enter into a funding agreement with the Government of Canada, as represented by the Minister of Indigenous Services and the Minister of Crown-Indigenous Service Relations and the Minister of Northern Affairs, for building emergency management capacity in PEI's First Nations Communities to support efficient and effective emergency response and recovery efforts, for the period April 1, 2020 to March 31, 2021, such as more particularly described in the draft agreement.

FINANCIAL ADMINISTRATION ACT **AUTHORIZATION FOR** TEMPORARY BORROWING

Pursuant to section 46 of the Financial Administration Act R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. F-9 Council authorized the Minister of Finance to borrow a maximum of twenty million dollars (\$20,000,000.00) from the Royal Bank of Canada, Charlottetown, by way of an overdraft on the government general account for the period 31 December 2020 through 31 December 2021.

PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND LANDS PROTECTION ACT PETITION TO ACQUIRE A LAND HOLDING GRIFFIN FAMILY HOLDINGS INC. (APPROVAL)

Pursuant to section 5 and section 9 of the Prince Edward Island Lands Protection Act R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. L-5 Council granted permission to Griffin Family Holdings Inc. of Elmsdale, Prince Edward Island to acquire a land holding of approximately one hundred and seven (107) acres of land at Nail Pond, Lot 1, Prince County, Province of Prince Edward Island, being acquired from Clarence J. Keefe and Marie Keefe, both of Ascension, Prince Edward Island PROVIDED THAT the said real property is identified for non-development use pursuant to the Land Identification Regulations (EC606/95) made under the said Act.

Griffin Incorporated of Elmsdale, Prince Edward Island to acquire, by lease, an interest in a land holding or land holdings of up to one thousand, four hundred (1,400) acres of land as part of the said corporation's aggregate land holdings.

PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND LANDS PROTECTION ACT APPLICATION TO LEASE LAND W.P. GRIFFIN INCORPORATED (APPROVAL)

Pursuant to section 5 and clause 5.3(1)(b) of the *Prince Edward Island Lands Protection Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. L-5 Council granted permission to W.P. Griffin Incorporated of Elmsdale, Prince Edward Island to acquire, by lease, an interest in a land holding or land holdings of up to one thousand, one hundred and fifty-five (1,155) acres of land as part of the said corporation's aggregate land holdings PROVIDED THAT the said W.P. Griffin Incorporated files a statement with the Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission within one year of the date of this Order and prior to 31 December in every subsequent year disclosing the parcel number, the acreage and the term of lease for each parcel leased during the reporting period covered by the statement.

PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND LANDS PROTECTION ACT PROPERTY NO. 052050, LOT 14, PRINCE COUNTY IDENTIFICATION FOR NON-DEVELOPMENT USE AMENDMENT

Pursuant to subsection 9(2) of the *Prince Edward Island Lands Protection Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. L-5, Council amended the condition of non-development use made pursuant to section 2 of the Land Identification Regulations (EC606/95) in respect of approximately seventy-three decimal eight one (73.81) acres of land, being Provincial Property No. 052050 located at Bayside, Lot 14, Prince County, Prince Edward Island and currently owned by Westcountry Farms Inc. of Tyne Valley, Prince Edward Island.

Council noted that this amendment will enable subdivision of a parcel of land of approximately eight decimal three four (8.34) acres for residential use and determined that following subdivision, identification for non-development use shall continue to apply to the new parcel and to the remaining land.

This Order-in-Council comes into force on December 8, 2020.

PROVINCIAL COURT ACT JUSTICE OF THE PEACE APPOINTMENT

Under authority of section 14 of the *Provincial Court Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. P-25 Council appointed Kendra Jeanise Smith of Summerside as a Justice of the Peace in and for the Province of Prince Edward Island for a term of five years, effective December 8, 2020.

Further, Council ordered that should the said Kendra Jeanise Smith cease to be employed in her present capacity in the Department of Justice and Public Safety, her appointment as a Justice of the Peace shall terminate coincident with the date her employment terminates.

PUBLIC HEALTH ACT CONTINUATION OF DECLARATION STATE OF PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY

WHEREAS a state of public health emergency was declared in Prince Edward Island on March 16, 2020, pursuant to Order-in-Council EC2020-174; and continued on April 15, 2020 by Order-in-Council EC2020-254; on May 15, 2020 by Order-in-Council EC2020-305; and on June 15, 2020 by Order-in-Council EC2020-350; on July 15, 2020 by Order-in-Council EC2020-435; on August 14, 2020 by Order-in-Council EC2020-488; on September 13, 2020 by Order-in-Council EC2020-603; and on November 12, 2020 by Order-in-Council EC2020-649;

WHEREAS Council has determined, on the advice of the Chief Public Health Officer, that a public health emergency continues to exist as a result of COVID-19 (coronavirus);

AND WHEREAS continued coordination of action or special measures are required in order to protect the public health of the population;

THEREFORE, Council continues Order-in-Council EC2020-174 pursuant to subsection 49(5) of the *Public Health Act*, R.S.P.E.I. Cap. P-30.1 effective December 12, 2020 for a period of thirty (30) days, unless it is sooner terminated or continued by Council.
