CHILD PROTECTION ACT REGULATIONS **AMENDMENT**

Pursuant to section 60 of the Child Protection Act R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. C-5.1, Council made the following regulations:

1. Section 15 of the Child Protection Act Regulations (EC215/03) is revoked and the following substituted:

15. (1) For the purpose of subsection 58(1) of the Act, an Advisory Members of Committee appointed by the Minister

Advisory Committee

- (a) shall consist of
 - (i) the Director, who shall serve as the chairperson of the committee,
 - (ii) one employee of the Department,
 - (iii) the designated representatives for each band council,
 - (iv) two persons, of whom at least one shall be a youth, who have received child protection services, and
 - (v) one person who has demonstrated an informed concern for the best interests of children; and
- (b) may include not more than two other persons determined by the Minister.
- (2) At least one of the members of an Advisory Committee shall be a Bilingual member person who is fluent in French and English.
- (3) The term of the members of an Advisory Committee expires on the Term of date the Advisory Committee reports to the Minister in accordance with appointment subsection 58(1) of the Act.
- (4) The Advisory Committee shall report to the Minister within four Report within four months months of being appointed.
- 2. These regulations come into force on January 30, 2021.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

SECTION 1 repeals and replaces section 15 of the regulations to amend the composition of an Advisory Committee.

SECTION 2 provides for the commencement of these regulations.
