


Notes regarding changes, FY2023/24:

- The report now includes the Stratford Coverage Zone that was created with the opening of the Crossroad Ambulance Station in 2020. Previous reports included the data now attributed to the Stratford zone within the Charlottetown zone.
- The definition of Response Time has also been updated to better represent the experience of individuals who call 9-1-1 requesting an ambulance. Response time previously indicated the time from paramedic notification to arrival on scene. The new definition reflects the elapsed time from when the 9-1-1 call is received at the Public Safety Answering Point (9-1-1 dispatch centre) until the arrival of the first paramedic on scene.
