## NEW/ENHANCED INVESTMENTS

### Social Housing Construction

\$12.7M for a new total of \$36.2M

New funding to construct additional senior and family housing units, transitional housing, and to support the completion of the 100 affordable units previously announced.

### Bridges

\$5.0M for a new total of \$36.5M

Funding for the repair and replacement of bridge infrastructure across PEI.

### Perimeter Highway Project

\$10.0M

The project will include three roundabouts for the intersections at MacWilliams, Angus, and McRae Drives, a new structure to support four lanes at Wrights Creek.

### Mark Arendz Provincial Ski Park

\$4.3M

Funding for upgrades required to host the 2023 Canada Winter Games.



## Continuing Investments

### National and Collector Highways

\$101.5M

Funding for the repair and replacement of the road infrastructure across PEI to improve and maintain safety on our roadways.

### Provincial Parks and Golf Courses

\$5.6M

Funding to provide upgrades to campsites within our provincial parks and golf courses. Including improved WiFi services, washroom upgrades, and the replacement of maintenance equipment.

### Provincial Museums

\$1.0M

Site specific capital projects at Beaconsfield (windows and roof), restoration at the Stanley Lindsay House, and the Taylor House.
