The people who make up our communities are the real source of strength in our province. We will continue to make historic investments in modernizing our infrastructure.

ENHANCED INVESTMENTS

Agriculture & Land Equipment

\$100K for a new total of \$250k

Upgrade field equipment, such as drones, GPS equipment and plotter for printing maps.

Golf Courses

\$1M for a new total of \$3M

Upgrades to the golf cart fleet, irrigation systems, mowers and other maintenance equipment.

Court Information System

\$600k for a new total of \$1.6M

PEI is partnering with four provinces and two territories to develop a Fully Automated Court Technology System (FACTS).

Fisheries Equipment

\$25K for a new total of 125K

Upgrade field equipment and repairs to wharf structures.

Provincial Parks

\$2.3M for a new total of \$3.8M

Upgrade camp sites to provide more full-service sites, improve WIFI, upgrade washrooms and replace maintenance equipment.

Provincial Museums

\$250K for a new total of \$1M

Capital projects at Beaconsfield and restoration at Stanley Lindsay House and Taylor House.

Light Fleet Vehicles

\$1.25M for a new total of \$6.25M

An additional \$250k per year added to begin transition to electric vehicles within the government fleet.

Electric Vehicle Charging Stations \$750K

To continue adding charging stations across PEI.

New Investments

Confederation Trail \$1.8M

Upgrades to the trail at Fullerton's Marsh.

Social Housing \$17.5M

Support for 100 government owned units to compliment the many other initiatives underway.

Biomass Heat \$6.6M

Continue installing biomass units at approximately 20 government owned facilities.
