Please arrive 20 minutes before your scheduled appointment. Patients who arrive late may need to have their appointments rescheduled. Please bring your provincial health card.

## **CT Pelvis with Contrast – Evening Exam Preparations**

- 1. Only drink clear fluids, no solid food for 4 hours prior to your appointment time.
- 2. Due to evening appointment, Gastrografin is adjusted as follows:
  - 1. Mix one bottle of Gastrografin (30 ml) with 900 ml of water or clear juice
  - 2. Drink half of the mixture at 7AM the day of your examination.
  - 3. Drink the remaining half of the mixture one hour prior to the examination

## NOTE:

It is imperative that the Gastrografin is diluted into the water or juice in the exact proportions stated above.

- 3. A full bladder is needed for the exam, so please do not void or empty your bladder for 1 hour prior to your exam
- 4. You may take your medications.
- 5. Insulin dependent diabetics may eat a regular diet.

Queen Elizabeth Hospital, Prince County Hospital, Kings County Memorial Hospital, Souris Hospital, Community Hospital, Western Hospital.
