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## **ENVIRONMENT TAX COMMISSIONS**

<u>Subsection 4(1)</u> of the <u>Regulations</u> to the <u>Revenue Administration Act</u> has been amended to change the calculation of commissions paid to registered vendors effective April 1, 2012. As a result of this amendment, registered vendors which reported more than \$10,000 in environment tax in the prior fiscal year of the Province are not eligible for a commission on the environment tax they collect and report to the Province in the current fiscal year of the Province.

Registered vendors which reported \$10,000 or less in environment tax in the prior fiscal year of the Province will continue to be eligible for a commission. However, the maximum commission allowed will be \$300 per fiscal year of the Province.

This change will be effective commencing with the April 2012 environment tax return.
