Guide to Laboratory Services

How to Collect a Semen Sample

(Complete Examination / Post-Vasectomy)

IMPORTANT: TO ENSURE ACCURATE TEST RESULTS, PLEASE FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY.

Collection container:

• Sterile specimen container (C&S)

Before Collection:

• Do not ejaculate (either through sexual intercourse or masturbating) for at least three (3) days before collection.

Collection instructions:

- Collect a sample in the sterile container provided by your physician.
- DO NOT collect the sample in a condom. Condoms contain a powder that destroys sperm.
- Ensure the entire semen sample is collected.
- Securely fasten the cover.

Check that you have:

Labeled both container and requisition with your NAME
Labeled both container and requisition with your Provincial Health Card
Number (as they appear on your Health Card)
Labeled both container and requisition with the Date and Time of collection

Transport:

- Specimen <u>must</u> be kept warm (body temperature) until delivery.
- Specimen **must** be received within two (2) hours of collection.
- Bring the specimen directly to the laboratory from 8:00am until 2:00pm, Monday to Friday. Specimens <u>cannot</u> be accepted after-hours, on weekends or holidays.
- Hand the specimen and requisition directly to laboratory staff.

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
