Energy Efficiency Equipment Rebates

Point of Sale rebates are available exclusively through NoE contractors for the installation of mini-split heat pumps, while other ENERGY STAR® certified heating equipment including geothermal heat pumps, water heating devices, biomass heating devices, and other energy saving products are also available to consumers direct

If you are interested in financing for the up-front costs, learn more about the Residential Home Heating Loan Program. If you would like a loan, you must apply for the loan before you install your equipment

For a heat pump rebate or a solar rebate, get started by contacting a Network of Excellence contractor. Look up a contractor near you at PrinceEdwardIsland.ca/Network

Solar Electric Rebates

Homes - \$500/kilowatt DC installed, up to 40% of installed costs, to a maximum of \$5,000

• To be eligible, the building must receive the residential rate on the electric bill

Businesses - \$350/kilowatt DC installed, up to 40% of installed costs, to a maximum of \$10,000

To be eligible, the building must receive the general service 1 rate or the small industrial rate on the electric bill

Farm buildings - \$1250/kilowatt DC, up to 40% of installed costs, to a maximum of \$35,000

• Must be a non-residential building owned and operated by a bona fide farmer

Winter Warming

Tenants and homeowners with low-to-moderate income can access free air-sealing and energy efficient upgrades

Rebates, incentives and instant savings to help you save money on your energy bills and make your home more comfortable

New Home Construction
