PEI 2024 Agriculture and Agri-Food Exports to the United States

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PEI Agriculture and Agri-food Exports to the United States - 2024

PEI's agriculture and agri-food sector is export-oriented. PEI's agriculture and agri-food sector exports increased by 3.23% in 2024 to \$1.05 billion, reaching an all-time high for the third consecutive year. PEI's agriculture and agri-food exports in 2025 represented about 40.41% of the province's total exports (all sectors) and 1.15% of Canada's total agriculture and agri-food exports.

PEI's agriculture and agrifood products are shipped around the world. The United States (US) is the largest importer of PEI agriculture and agri-food products. In 2024, the US accounted for 91.86% of PEI's total agriculture and agri-food exports, with sales valued at \$969 million (a \$30 million increase from 2023).

PEI Potato Exports to United States

Fresh and processed potatoes contributed about \$935.95 million in international sales in 2024. The US is a major destination for PEI potatoes. In 2024, PEI potato exports to the US totaled \$859.49 million (equating to 91.83% of PEI's total potato exports). Prepared or preserved potatoes represented 81.68% (valuing \$702.07 million) of PEI's total potato exports to the US, followed by fresh potatoes (17.79%), valued at \$152.93 million. In 2024, dehydrated potato products accounted for less than 1% of PEI's total potato exports to the US.

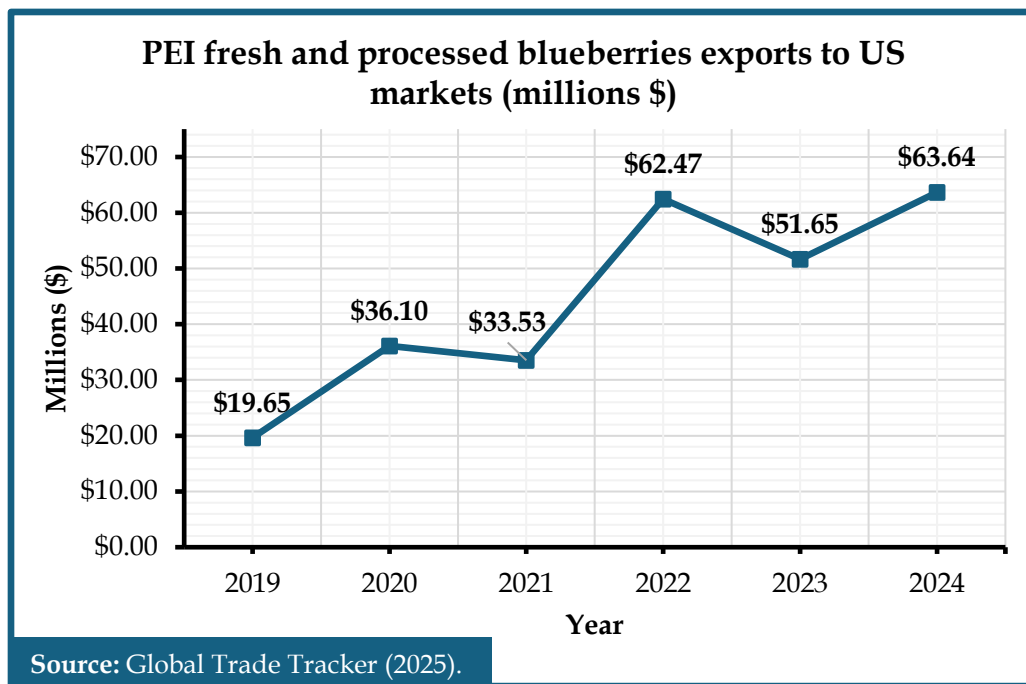
PEI Blueberry Exports to United States

Blueberries represent the second largest agricultural export in PEI. Almost all of the blueberries cultivated in PEI are wild blueberries. Highbush blueberries account for less than 1% of total blueberry production in PEI. In 2024, the blueberry sector generated approximately \$65.40 million in international sales of fresh and processed blueberries. About 97.32% of the fresh and processed blueberries from PEI were exported to the US, valued at \$63.64 million.
