Pursuant to subsection 5(1) of the *Public Departments Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. P-29 Council

1. Disestablished the Department of Agriculture, Fisheries, Aquaculture and Forestry.
2. Disestablished the Department of Environment and Energy.
3. (a) established the Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Aquaculture;
