PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND POTATO BOARD

PB08-1 Effective: 12 March, 2008

UNDER the <u>Natural Products Marketing Act</u>, R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap.N-3, the Prince Edward Island Potato Marketing Plan Regulations, and the <u>Agricultural Products Marketing Act</u> (Canada), the Prince Edward Island Potato Board makes the following order:

Packaging Order - Amendment

Application

- This order is amended to provide regulations for the manufacturing, distribution and marketing of packages bearing registered trade marks or official marks vested in the Prince Edward Island Potato Board.
- 2. Board Order PB91-2 is amended by the addition of the following as Section 5.1:

Trade Marks or Official Marks

- 5.1(1) No person shall manufacture or distribute packages bearing registered trade marks or official marks vested in the Prince Edward Island Potato Board unless the manufacturer has entered into a license agreement with the Prince Edward Island Potato Board respecting the use of such trade marks or official marks.
- 5.1(2) No person shall market potatoes in packages manufactured or distributed in contravention of sub-section (1).
- 5.1(3) Potatoes marketed in packages manufactured or distributed in contravention of sub-section (1) may be seized and detained by the Prince Edward Island Potato Board, in addition to any other remedies to which it may be entitled by law.

Commencement

3. THIS ORDER comes into force on the 12th day of March, 2008.

EMPLOYMENT STANDARDS ACT MINIMUM WAGE ORDER AMENDMENT

(Approved by the Administrator dated 11 March 2008.)

Pursuant to clause 5(1)(b) of the *Employment Standards Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. E-6.2 Council approved the following Minimum Wage Order made by the Employment Standards Board:

- 1. Section 1 of the *Employment Standards Act* Minimum Wage Order (EC139/96) is revoked and the following is substituted:
- The minimum rate of wages for all employees shall be: \$7.75 per hour effective 1 May 2008.
 \$8.00 per hour effective 1 October 2008.

Minimum rate

2. This Order comes into force on May 1, 2008.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

This adjustment in the minimum wage rate is based on an annual review by the Employment Standards Board, undertaken in accordance with subsection 5(2) of the Act.

PLANNING ACT SUBDIVISION AND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS AMENDMENT

(Approved by the Administrator dated 11 March 2008.)

Pursuant to sections 8 and 8.1 of the *Planning Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. P-8, Council made the following regulations:

1. Section 63 of the *Planning Act* Subdivision and Development Regulations (EC693/00) is amended

(a) by the addition of the following after subsection (3):

Definition

(3.1) In this section, "existing parcel" means a parcel of land that existed on July 9, 1994.

(b) in subsection (5),

- (i) in clause (a), by the deletion of the words "an owner of the parcel to provide lots for the children of the owner" and the substitution of the words "the owner of an existing parcel to provide lots for the children of that owner", and
- (ii) by the revocation of subclauses (a)(i) to (iv) and the substitution of the following:
- (i) the owner files, with an application to subdivide the existing parcel, a statutory declaration that he or she will convey the lots only to his or her children and only for the use as a single family dwelling,
- (ii) no child of the owner will receive more than one lot,
- (iii) the total number of lots that may be subdivided from all of the existing parcels owned by an owner pursuant to this subsection is equal to or less than the number of children of that owner at the time of the application, and

(c) by the addition of the following after subsection (5):

"remnant parcel", defined (5.01) In subsection (5.02), "remnant parcel" means, in respect of an existing parcel, the portion of the existing parcel that has not been approved for subdivision into one or more lots under subsection (4), (5) or (5.1).

Subdivision of remnant

- (5.02) An approval to subdivide a remnant parcel may be granted, as if the remnant parcel were an existing parcel, under
 - (a) any clause of subsection (4) or (5); or
 - (b) subsection (5.1),

if no previous approval to subdivide has been granted under such a clause of subsection (4) or (5), or under subsection (5.1), as the case may be, in respect of any land forming part of the existing parcel.

- (d) in subsection (7),
 - (i) in the wording preceding clause (a), by the addition of the words "or (5.02)" after the words "the uses and limitations contained in subsection (4)", and
 - (ii) in clause(a), by the deletion of the words "on July 9, 1994".
- 2. These regulations come into force on March 22, 2008.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

SECTION 1 clarifies the definition of "existing parcel", clarifies the rules that allow the owner of an existing parcel to further subdivide land to give it to that person's children, clarifies the rules for dealing with the subdivision of a remnant of an existing parcel and removes an unneeded reference to a date.

SECTION 2 provides for the commencement of these regulations.
