- (ii) by the deletion of the words "real property tax notice" and the substitution of the words "notice of taxation"; and

- (6.2) Where an applicant for a fish buying license for lobster makes an Idem application for that license during a lobster season, the Minister shall, within 3 business days after receipt of the application,
 - (a) review the application; and
 - (b) if the Minister is satisfied that the fish buying license for lobster should be issued to the applicant, issue that license to the applicant.
- (2) Subsection 9(7) of the regulations is amended by the addition of the words ", (6.1) or (6.2)" after the words "subsection (6)".
- 2. These regulations come into force on May 16, 2008.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

These regulations permit an applicant to make an application for a fish buying license for lobster during a lobster season and during the 29 day period prior to the start of a season. Currently, applications for such licenses must be submitted at least 30 days prior to the start of a lobster season.
