EPPEI 10-01 EGG PRODUCERS OF PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND

BOARD ORDER: EPPEI 10-01 EFFECTIVE: January 24, 2010 ISSUED: January 14, 2010

Under the Prince Edward Island Egg Commodity Marketing Regulations and the *Natural Products Marketing Act*, R.S.P.E.I.1988, Cap. N-3, the Egg Producers of Prince Edward Island makes the following Order:

AMENDMENT TO BOARD ORDER ECMB 88-2

Application 1. This Order amends the levy rate contained in Subsection 6(a) of Board Order 88-2.

Levy rate amended

2. Subsection 6(a) of Board Order 88-2 is hereby deleted and the following substituted therefor:

6. (a) A levy on ungraded eggs shall be assessed annually by the Board on each producer, subject to change by the Board, and the levy shall be based on the producer's allocated quota at the rate of thirty three point five zero cents (\$0.3350) per dozen eggs, plus applicable provincial and federal taxes, and it is established that the number of eggs per bird for levy calculation purposes shall be twenty four point nine, nine (24.99) dozen eggs per annum except that during a year that has fifty-three (53) weeks the number of eggs per bird shall be twenty-five point four seven (25.47) dozen eggs per annum.

Commencement

3. This Order shall come into force on the 24th day of January, 2010.
