JUDICATURE ACT AND INTERPRETATION ACT ACTING PROTHONOTARY OF THE COURT OF APPEAL AND THE SUPREME COURT LORETTA COADY MACAULAY APPOINTMENT

Having under consideration clause 20(e) of the *Interpretation Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. I-8, and under authority of subsection 27(2) of the *Judicature Act*, R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. EMERGENCY 911 ACT GENERAL REGULATIONS AMENDMENT

(Approved by Her Honour the Lieutenant Governor in Council dated 11 January 2011.)

Pursuant to section 10 of the *Emergency 911 Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. E-5.1, Council made the following regulations:

- 1. Subsections 3(3) and (4) of the *Emergency 911 Act* General Regulations (EC155/00) are amended by the deletion of the words "Department of Community and Cultural Affairs, Planning and Inspections Division" and the substitution of the words "Department of Justice and Public Safety, 911 Administration Office".
- 2. Section 6 of the regulations is amended
 - (a) in subsection (2), by the deletion of the words "Provincial Treasurer" and the substitution of the words "Minister of Finance and Municipal Affairs"; and
 - (b) in subsections (2) and (3), by the deletion of the words "911 administration" and the substitution of the words "911 Administration Office".
- 3. These regulations come into force on January 22, 2011.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

SECTION 1 provides for the name of the department and office responsible for 911 administration to be updated, by replacing Community and Cultural Affairs, Planning and Inspection Division to Department of Justice and Public Safety, 911 Administration Office.

SECTION 2 provides for the replacement of the former name of Provincial Treasurer to the Minister of Finance and Municipal Affairs' current name and for the replacing of 911 administration with 911 Administration Office.

SECTION 3 provides for the commencement of these regulations.

- 3. Subsection 7(8) of the regulations is amended by the deletion of the words "Provincial Treasury" and the substitution of the words "Department of Finance and Municipal Affairs".
- 4. These regulations come into force on January 22, 2011.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

SECTIONS 1 and 2 provide for the name of the Provincial Treasurer to be replaced with the Minister's current name under the *Public Departments Act* R.S.P.E.I 1988, Cap. P-29: Minister of Finance and Municipal Affairs.

SECTION 3 provides for the name of the former department of Provincial Treasury to be replaced with the department's current name: Department of Finance and Municipal Affairs.

SECTION 4 provides for the commencement of these regulations.

 - (h) by the addition of the following after the entry relating to section 281:
- 282 abduction in contravention of custody order
- 283 abduction
- 2. These regulations come into force on January 22, 2011.
