**MUNICIPALITIES ACT
AND
THE VILLAGE SERVICES ACT, 1954
COMPOSITION OF MUNICIPAL COUNCIL
COMMUNITY OF ST. LOUIS
APPROVED**

Having under consideration Order-in-Council No. 22/55 and a Proclamation issued on January 12, 1965 pursuant to *The Village Services Act, 1954*, a resolution approved by the Community of St. Louis on October 7, 2013, and a recommendation from the Minister of Finance, Energy and Municipal Affairs, Executive Council hereby accepts the request of the Community of St. Louis to increase the composition of its council, effective the date of the next municipal election, to a total of seven members, being a chairperson and six councillors, in accordance with clause 15(1)(b) of the *Municipalities Act*, R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. M-13.

**PROVINCIAL COURT ACT
JUSTICE OF THE PEACE
APPOINTMENT**

Under authority of section 14 of the *Provincial Court Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. P-25, Council appointed Chesa L. Morley of Charlottetown in Queens County, Prince Edward Island, as a Justice of the Peace in and for the Counties of Prince, Queens and Kings in the Province of Prince Edward Island for the period 10 February 2014 to 10 October 2016.

Further, Council ordered that should Chesa L. Morley cease to be employed in her present capacity in the Department of Environment, Labour and Justice, that her appointment as a Justice of the Peace shall terminate coincident with the date her employment terminates.

Registration | <p>3. CQM registration is a mandatory requirement for marketing milk. No person shall sell or offer to sell milk who has not been registered or issued conditional registration in accordance with this order.</p> |

| Record Keeping | 5. All specific forms and documents required for CQM record keeping are contained in the CQM Workbook, copies of which are available from the Board office and are supplied to producers on demand. In any instance where alternate forms of record keeping are desired, Board personnel shall provide guidance and assistance to ensure the alternate forms of record keeping meet CQM requirements. |
| CQM Standards | 6. CQM standards are established in the CQM Reference Manual, which is available to all dairy producers in Prince Edward Island. A dairy producer must meet the CQM standards as established in the manual to achieve CQM registration. Edits to the reference manual are forwarded to dairy producers as they are released. (For convenience, the list of program standards below is broken into categories of related items denoted by bold print category headers. Where applicable, numbers in brackets at the end of each item are the reference numbers for that item on the validation checklist). In accordance with the CQM Reference Manual, a dairy producer shall: |

Dairy Facilities, Pesticides and Nutrient Management

- a. Be registered to ship milk with Dairy Farmers of PEI, as evidenced by a registration number issued by the Board (1);
- b. Use only pesticides registered for use in the milk house, barn and fields (2);
- c. Use registered pesticides according to their labels and pre-harvest intervals to harvest or grazing guidelines shall be followed (3);
- d. Store pesticides, treated seed and fertilizer in a safe, secure manner according to provincial dairy regulations (4);
- e. Ensure that an anti-backflow device is installed on any hose used for filling pesticide sprayers or containers that is connected to the milk house or barn water system (5);
- f. Ensure that animal husbandry, manure and water management systems sustain the cleanliness of lactating cattle's udders (6);
- g. Restrict cattle access to manure storage or manure run-off (7);
- h. Clear the lane-way and loading area of manure contamination at the time of milk pick-up (8);
- i. Acquire the appropriate approval and permits if using sewage sludge (9);

Feed

- j. Establish and implement a standard operating procedure if using medicated feeds (13);
- k. Clearly mark storage containers for medicated feeds that have milk or meat withdrawals, or are prohibited for use in lactating cattle, so the feed can be identified by those who handle it (14);

l. Store and handle pet foods or feeds that are labeled not for use for ruminants (i.e. clearly labeled with the warning: Feeding this product to cattle, sheep, deer or other ruminants is illegal and is subject to fines or other punishment under the *Health of Animals Act*) to avoid feeding to cattle or cross contaminating feeds for cattle (15);

Animal Health and Biosecurity

m. Identify all cattle according to the National Livestock Identification for Dairy (NLID) program, or according to Agri-Tracabilité Québec (ATQ) (18);

n. Identify all cattle to allow for the maintenance of treatment records (e.g. ear tags) (19);

Medicines and Chemicals Used on Livestock

o. Maintain a list of all medicines and chemicals that are used on livestock (23);

p. Store medicines, chemicals, syringes and needles used on livestock in a clean and sanitary manner, in a dedicated place, and according to label directions (24);

q. Store and handle medicines and chemicals used on livestock in a manner that will not contaminate milk, meat, or feeds (25);

r. Store livestock medicines and chemicals for non-lactating and lactating dairy cattle, and products not intended for dairy cattle in a separate area or cupboard (26);

s. Use only livestock medicines (including medicated foot-baths) that are approved in Canada for use in dairy cattle, and use them according to the label, or according to written veterinary prescriptions. Obtain written veterinary prescriptions for every treatment administered not according to the label and for every veterinary drug use that is not approved for use in Canada (27);

t. Record the identity of any animal and treatment site for any treatment that resulted in an irretrievable broken needle (28);

u. Mark all treated cattle in the milking herd to identify those that have milk withdrawals (e.g. leg bands) (29);

v. Maintain a permanent written record of all medicines and chemicals used on livestock that have a milk or meat withdrawal (30);

w. Establish and implement a standard operating procedure for treating cattle (31);

x. Record all problems that occur following treatments administered to animals and the corrective actions that were taken (32);

Milking Management

y. Establish and implement a standard operating procedure for pre-milking and milking (35, 36);

z. Clean, sanitize and dry teats thoroughly before milking (e.g. manure and teat dips removed) using approved products (37);

aa. Establish and implement a standard operating procedure to minimize the risk of shipping abnormal milk (38);

Milking Treated Animals

bb. Establish and implement a standard operating procedure to minimize the risk of shipping milk from treated cattle (39);

cc. Follow the recommended milk withdrawal times for medicated feeds, livestock pesticides and livestock medicines (including ensuring that when an animal calves or aborts that the withdrawal time for any dry cow treatment given has been followed) (40);

dd. Test the milk from a newly purchased animal for inhibitors before the milk enters the bulk tank and do not ship the milk unless results are negative and results are recorded, or the purchaser must obtain a letter of guarantee from the previous owner covering the last 60 days (41);

ee. Record any problems that occur regarding milk residues and the corrective actions that were taken (42);

Cooling and Storage of Milk

ff. Record the bulk tank temperature after every milking (43);

gg. Record any problems that occur regarding cooling and storage of milk and the corrective actions that were taken (44);

hh. Use approved cleaning products according to the accessible milk house cleaning and sanitizing chart (46);

ii. Inspect and record the cleanliness of milking equipment on a regular basis (e.g. receiver jar and bulk milk tank) (minimum acceptable frequency is monthly, weekly is recommended) (47);

jj. Check and record the end temperature of the wash water (hot detergent cycle) once a month (48);

kk. Record any problems that occur regarding equipment sanitation and wash water temperature and the corrective actions that were taken (49);

ll. Establish and implement a standard operating procedure for post-milking system cleaning (50);

mm. Complete annually, a professional evaluation of the wash system and correct any deficiencies that are identified (51);

nn. Use the milk house exclusively for cooling and storing milk and for cleaning, sanitizing, and storing materials and equipment used in the production and handling of milk (52);

oo. Store cleaning chemicals in a location and manner that will prohibit the contamination of milk (53);

pp. Keep the milk house and external surfaces of the milking and milk storage equipment clean at all times (54);

qq. Implement a functioning safety switch or fail-safe system to avoid accidental entry of wash water into the tank (55);

rr. Remove all mercury thermometers and vacuum columns from the milk house (56);

ss. Cover all lights near the bulk tank opening with a protective covering or use bulbs with a protective safety coating (57);

Use of Water for Cleaning Milk Contact Surfaces

tt. Test water that is used for milking equipment sanitation annually to ensure that it meets the microbiological parameters determined by the provincial authority and be able to provide water test results upon request (59);

uu. Record any problems that occur regarding water quality and the corrective actions that were taken (60);

Shipping Animals

vv. Follow the recommended meat withdrawal times for livestock medicines, livestock pesticides and medicated feeds (61);

ww. Establish and implement a standard operating procedure to minimize the risk of shipping treated animals and animals carrying physical hazards (e.g. broken needles) (62);

xx. Record any problems that occur regarding shipping animals and the corrective actions that were taken (63);

Training Farm Staff & Communicating with CQM Staff

yy. Train existing and new staff to implement or maintain the CQM program on farm and grant all staff access to standard operating procedures, corrective action plans and records that are developed and maintained (64);

zz. Keep written corrective action plans on how to communicate and address the following situations (65) -

- I. Incorrect administration of medicines or other chemicals to an animal;
- II. Entry of milk from a treated animal into the bulk milk tank;
- III. Improperly cooled or stored milk;
- IV. Failure to properly clean milk contact surfaces;
- V. Improper water temperature;
- VI. Milking equipment water contaminated with bacteria; and
- VII. Sale of a treated animal, or an animal with a broken needle and the buyer was not informed;

Other

aaa. During the term any CQM registration is in force, changes in farm practices,

operations or equipment that have been previously validated must be reported to DFPEI. The CQM coordinator or a validator shall determine if the changes require a new validation and shall ensure that CQM standards continue to be met. If required, the producer may be designated as conditionally registered until the changes have been fully validated.

bbb. All corrective actions from the previous validation must be addressed.

CQM Validators 7. CQM validators shall perform a validation to determine compliance with the CQM standards as defined by this order. CQM validators are employed or contracted by the Board. They must complete a specific course of training and on-the-job experience to be employed in that role. A CQM validator shall be assigned by the Board to perform each validation.

Validation
Process

8. The validator shall complete a validation checklist as a means of performing the validation to determine the producer's compliance with CQM standards (a copy of the validation checklist is provided to all producers and is available through the Board office). The validation checklist classifies each CQM standard as a major compliance, minor compliance, or demerit point item. Validation must be completed at least annually, as scheduled by the Board, in accordance with the methods specified in the CQM Reference Manual. Validation may be required more often if there is evidence that a producer has failed to meet CQM standards.

Self-declaration 9. A self-declaration is a form of validation that permits the producer to complete a questionnaire for submission to the Board. The completed questionnaire and required supporting documentation is evaluated by the CQM coordinator or a validator to confirm compliance with this order, in lieu of an on-farm examination of records by a validator. Producers may be permitted to complete a self-declaration if their last regularly scheduled validation was not a self declaration and their two previous validations demonstrated compliance with this order.

If validation is offered through a self-declaration, the self declaration must be completed and returned to the Board by the date specified on the self-declaration form, approximately one month after the request and form have been presented to the producer. Failure to return a self-declaration in the allotted time is considered a major deficiency. The producer shall be notified in accordance with CQM program guidelines and the deficiency shall be subject to the same corrective action as any other CQM deficiency.

Deficiencies 10. A deficiency is a failure to meet any standard established in this order. Deficiencies shall be determined to be major compliance deficiencies, minor compliance deficiencies or demerit point deficiencies in accordance with the CQM Reference Manual, and as specified in the CQM Validation Checklist.

Corrective
Actions

11. If deficiencies are recorded on any validation, the validation report shall be sent to the producer from the DFPEI office indicating the outstanding deficiencies, together with directions entitled Corrective Action Requests specifying the actions required to correct those deficiencies. Failure to complete required corrective actions and submit any specified documentation within one month of the date of validation shall result in the producer being deemed non-compliant and in violation of this order.

Violation 12. A milk producer who has failed to meet the standards specified in this order and who has failed to implement corrective actions within one month of the due date of any validation is in violation of this order and shall:

a. be designated as holding a conditional CQM registration; and

b. be subject to the following penalties:

- i. for the calendar month in which the violation occurs (one month following the validation date): \$5.00 per hl;
- ii. for the calendar month following the month in which the violation first occurs (second month following the validation date): \$10.00 per hl, and may be required to appear before the Board or a committee of the Board to confirm the producer is taking appropriate actions to achieve CQM Registration;
- iii. for the second calendar month following the month in which that violation first occurs (third month following the validation date): \$15.00 per hl; and
- iv. three and one half months following the validation date (one hundred and six days after the original validation is performed) the conditional registration shall be revoked and the producer shall be prohibited from selling milk or offering to sell milk until conditional registration is achieved.

c. A producer who has failed to complete corrective actions within one hundred and five days of their validation and who has been subject to revocation of conditional registration shall require a new validation that will be completed at their expense, prior to receiving CQM Registration or conditional registration.

Compliance
after violation

13. A producer who has been in violation and has subsequently completed all corrective actions shall be deemed in compliance with this order. CQM Registration shall be granted at the completion of the specified conditional registration period, or sooner, at the discretion of the Board.

Conditional
Registration

14. A conditional registration is intended to allow a new dairy producer time to: commence operations, establish practices and create documents required for CQM; record at least three months of operating data as required by CQM; and be validated. A conditional registration shall be granted to a new producer who fulfills the conditions specified in this Section for a period not exceeding six months.

A conditional registration shall also be issued to a producer who is found in violation of this order as specified in Section 12.

Conditional registrations are subject to the following conditions:

a. Minimum requirements for new producers:

- i. create a plan for achieving CQM registration;
- ii. receive approval from the CQM Coordinator for the plan; and
- iii. implement the plan and complete all CQM requirements that may be achieved prior to beginning milk production.

b. A producer who has been issued a conditional registration shall:

- i. maintain all records as directed in the CQM Reference Manual;
- ii. ensure all CQM records are available for verification as required;
- iii. submit a copy of all records completed during the conditional registration period to the Board on a monthly basis or as specified in the registration

plan or by the Board;

- iv. in any instance where records are maintained by an electronic means, such as a digital time-temperature recorder, ensure the equipment is available for random verification by representatives of the Board; and
- v. be subject to additional conditions imposed by the Board, as required to ensure CQM standards are met.

c. If a producer has not achieved CQM Registration during the term of conditional registration, the conditional registration may not be renewed or extended without the review and approval of the Board or a committee designated by the Board.

d. A conditional registration may be immediately revoked and the producer prohibited from selling or offering to sell milk if the conditions specified in this order or directed by the Board are not met.

CQM

Registration

15. A producer who has met all standards specified in this order as demonstrated by a CQM validation shall be registered in CQM. Registration shall continue in force until the next validation is due.

Commencement

16. This Order comes into force on the 31st day of January 2014.

Revocation

17. DFPEI Order 2011-08 is hereby revoked.
