UNDER the *Natural Products Marketing Act*, R.S.P.E.I. 1988 Cap. N-3, and the Prince Edward Island Cattle Producers Commodity Marketing Board Regulations, the Prince Edward Island Cattle Producers makes the following order:

Dead Stock Service Levies Order

- Short title 1. This order may be cited as the Prince Edward Island Cattle Producers Dead Stock Service Levies Order.
- Application 2. This order applies to the fixing, imposing and collecting of dead stock levies payable by all beef producers in the Province of Prince Edward Island.
- Interpretation 3(1). The words herein shall have the meanings as found in the Prince Edward Island *Natural Products Marketing Act* and the Cattle Marketing Board Regulations unless differentiated herein and as hereinafter defined:
- (a) “Backgrounder Operator” means a producer which adds value to calves (either owned by the producer or custom fed for other producers) in the form of weight gain in preparation for feedlot production.
 - (b) “Category” means any one of the categories of cow-calf producer, a back-grounder operator, a feedlot operator or a drover.
 - (c) “Cow-Calf Producer” means a producer which maintains a permanent herd of breeding cows, heifers and, where necessary, bulls, for the purpose of producing calves.
 - (d) “Dead Stock Service Levy” means the levy which will be billed to each producer annually no later than March 31 of each year.
 - (e) “Dead Stock Service Provider” means an entity which physically removes dead cattle stock from a farm and is responsible for its disposal.
 - (f) “Discounted Levy” means the actual dead stock service levy that a producer must pay if such producer has registered pursuant to Section 5 by January 31 of each year
 - (g) “Drover” means a person who buys cattle from producers for resale to slaughter houses, to producers or through auction barns;
 - (h) “Feed Lot Operator” means a producer which raises cattle during the final stage of production prior to processing.
 - (i) “Quota Holder” means any cattle producer who is a quota holder as defined in the Dairy Farmers of Prince Edward Island Regulations.

	3(2).	The mortality rate for any producer shall be determined as follows:
	(a)	each producer shall be deemed to have cattle inventory (in the case of cow-calf producers) or cattle marketings (in the case of background operators, feed lot operators or drovers) in the maximum amount stated for the range of such cattle inventory or cattle marketings set forth in Schedule "2" in which the producer's actual cattle inventory or cattle marketings, as the case may be, falls;
	(b)	the amount determined in accordance with subparagraph (a) shall be divided into the number of dead stock picked up from such producer in the previous year, as determined from the pickup slips to December 31 of each year provided by the dead stock service provider.
Exemption	4.	Any registered cattle producer showing proof of being a quota holder under the Dairy Farmers of Prince Edward Island Regulations shall be exempt from having to pay dead stock levies to the Prince Edward Island Cattle Producers.
Requirement to Register	5.	Every cattle producer shall register with the Board annually by January 31 of each year by completion of the cattle producer registration form set forth as Schedule "1" to this order.
Levy	6(1).	Every cow-calf producer shall pay to the Board annual dead stock levies based on their cattle inventory as determined in accordance with Schedule 2 to this order.
	6(2).	Every background operator, feedlot operator and drover shall pay to the Board annual dead stock levies based on their annual cattle marketings determined in accordance with Schedule 2 to this Board Order.
	6(3).	Any producer who falls into more than one category of producer shall be invoiced based on the combination of the producer's categories.
Failure to Register	7.	If a cattle producer fails to submit the registration form set forth in Schedule "1" by January 31 of each year, then such producer's inventory or marketings (depending upon the category of such producer) shall be determined by the Board to be the greater of the following, and the dead stock service levy payable by such producer determined by such calculation: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a). an amount determined by assuming that the producer's dead stock pickups in the previous year constituted six percent of such producer's inventory or marketings (depending on the category of producer); or (b). an estimate of such producer's inventory or marketings (depending on the category of producer) estimated by the Board in good faith.
Additional Levy	8.	A producer having a mortality rate above six percent will be assessed an additional levy of \$100 per head for every dead animal picked up by the dead stock service provider in the previous year in excess of the six percent mortality rate, which additional levy will be invoiced at the same time as the levy set forth in Section 6.
Statement of Receipts	9.	When requested to do so by the Board, every registered producer shall forward to the Board a statement of the number of animals marketed per year.

Method of Payment	10(1). Remittances of dead stock services levies are payable to The Prince Edward Island Cattle Producers and are due 30 days after the date invoices are issued in March of each year.
	10(2). Notwithstanding subsection (1), producers whose dead stock service levies are greater than \$500 annually may pay such levies in three equal installments on March 31, June 30 and September 30 of each year.
Arrears and Penalties	11(1). Any dead stock service provider shall be given a list of all producers whose dead stock service levies are up to date.
	11(2). Any producer whose levy payment installments are outstanding for 60 days shall not be in good standing with Prince Edward Island Cattle Producers.
	11(3). No pick-up service will be available for producers who are not in good standing with the Prince Edward Island Cattle Producers.
	11(4). A producer not in good standing must allow up to seven days for a payment to be processed before the service provider will be notified that the dead stock producer is in good standing.
	11(5). A list of producers in good standing will be shared with the PEI Department of Agriculture and the PEI Department of Environment and updated periodically.
	11(6). An additional administration fee of 2.5% will be added monthly to any account that is in arrears sixty days or more.
	11(7). Producers who do not pay their dead stock service levies will not be eligible for programs offered through the Prince Edward Island Cattle Producers.

Commencement	This order shall come into force on March 1, 2014.

1. The title of the *Public Health Act* Eating Establishments and Licensed Premises Regulations (EC16/79) is amended by the deletion of the words “EATING ESTABLISHMENTS AND LICENSED” and the substitution of the word “FOOD”.

2. Clause 1(e) of the regulations is revoked.

3. (1) Clauses 1(f) and (l) of the regulations are amended by the deletion of the words “an eating establishment or licensed” and the substitution of the words “a food”.

(2) The regulations are amended in the following provisions by the deletion of the words “eating establishment or licensed” and the substitution of the word “food”:

(a) section 2;

(b) subsection 3(1);

(c) section 5;

(d) subsection 28(1).

4. Section 1.1 of the regulations is revoked and the following substituted:

1.1 (1) These regulations apply to the classes of food premises set out in the Schedule to these regulations. Classes of food premises

(2) The fee for a license for a class of food premises is the fee set out for that class in the Schedule to these regulations. License fee

5. The headings immediately before sections 3, 4 and 12 are amended by the deletion of the words “EATING ESTABLISHMENTS AND LICENSED” and the substitution of the word “FOOD”.

6. Section 6 of the regulations is amended by the deletion of the words “an eating establishment” and the substitution of the words “a food premises”.

7. Section 12 of the regulations is amended by the deletion of the words “eating establishment and licensed” and the substitution of the word “food”.

8. Section 23 of the regulations is amended by the deletion of the words “eating establishment” and the substitution of the words “food premises”.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

SECTION 1 amends the title of the regulations to refer to “Food Premises” rather than “Eating Establishments and Licensed Premises”. This change reflects the new terminology introduced by the *Public Health Act*, R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. P-30.1.

SECTION 2 revokes clause 1(e) of the regulations to remove the definition of “eating establishment”, which is no longer used in the regulations.

SECTION 4 revokes section 1.1 of the regulations and substitutes a new section 1.1 that provides that the classes of food premises to which the regulations apply, and the fee for each class, are those set out in the Schedule to the regulations.

SECTION 5 amends three headings in the regulations to remove references to “eating establishments” and substitute references to “food premises”.

SECTION 6 amends section 6 of the regulations to remove a reference to “eating establishments and licensed premises” and substitute a reference to “food premises”.

SECTION 7 amends section 12 of the regulations to remove a reference to “eating establishment and licensed premises” and substitute a reference to “food premises”.

SECTION 8 amends section 23 of the regulations to remove a reference to “eating establishment” and substitute a reference to “food premises”.

SECTION 9 amends section 24 of the regulations to remove a reference to “eating establishment or licensed premises” and substitute a reference to “food premises”, and to correct a grammatical error.

SECTION 10 revokes subsections 28(2) to (5) of the regulations.

SECTION 11 amends clause 33(b) of the regulations to remove a reference to “eating establishments” and substitute a reference to “food premises”.

SECTION 12 amends subsection 40(2) of the regulations to include a fee for reinstatement of a license and to indicate that the fees are those set out in the Schedule to the regulations, and revokes subsection 40(5).

EXPLANATORY NOTES

SECTION 1 amends subsection 5(1) of the regulations to add the Chief Electoral Officer to the list of persons to whom the Director may disclose identifying information.

SECTION 2 amends subsection 7(1) of the regulations to update the fees charged and the list of services provided under the Act.

SECTION 3 amends Schedule A of the regulations by revoking Forms 3, 4 and 11 and substituting new Forms for them, and adding new Forms 10.1, an application for a search of records by Vital Statistics, and 11.1, an application for a record of a marriage or death.

SECTION 4 provides for the commencement of these regulations.
