CHICKEN FARMERS OF PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND

BOARD ORDER: CFPEI 16-01
EFFECTIVE: May 18, 2014

Under the *Natural Products Marketing Act*, R.S.P.E.I., 1988, Cap. N-3, the Chicken Farmers of Prince Edward Island (formerly Poultry Meat Commodity Marketing Board) Marketing Regulations and the Prince Edward Island Chicken Order made pursuant to the *Agricultural Products Marketing Act* (Canada), the Chicken Farmers of Prince Edward Island makes the following order:

LEVY ORDER

1. This order establishes the levy on chicken marketed by Prince Edward Island producers.
2. (1) The meaning of words herein shall be as defined herein or, if not defined, as in the *Natural Products Marketing Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. N -3 and the Chicken Farmers of Prince Edward Island Chicken Farmers Marketing Regulations.

(2) In this order:
 - a) "CFC" means the Chicken Farmers of Canada formed under the *Farm Products Agencies Act* (Canada).
 - b) "Board" means the Chicken Farmers of Prince Edward Island;
 - c) "Chicken" means a chicken of any class or parts thereof produced in the Province of Prince Edward Island, but does not include a chicken that is;
 - I. Five months or older,
 - II. Ten days or younger, or
 - III. Used in egg production;
3. A producer who produces and markets poultry meat from less than 500 chickens in a calendar year is exempt from this order.
4. The Board hereby imposes a levy on each producer of \$0.0153 per kilogram of live weight of chicken marketed by the producer, plus applicable taxes, of which \$0.0053 per kilogram shall be remitted to CFC by the Board and the remaining \$0.0100 per kilogram shall be retained for administration of the Board.
5. The levy imposed by section 4 shall;
 - a) Be paid by the producer where the chickens are:
 - I. Sold by the producer to a person other than a processor;
 - II. Processed either directly or indirectly by the producer; or
 - III. Processed by a processor on his behalf.
 - b) Where the chickens are purchased by a processor from a producer, be collected by the processor by deducting the amount of the levy from the monies payable by the processor to the producer.

6. The levy imposed by section 4 to be paid by a producer pursuant to clause 5(a) or to be collected by a processor pursuant to 5(b) shall be remitted to the Board at such address as the Board may direct not later than the 15th day of the month next following the month in which the chickens were processed.
7. Board Order PMCMB08-01 dated February 2nd, 2008 is hereby revoked.
8. This Order is effective May 18th, 2014

BOARD ORDER: CFPEI 16-02
EFFECTIVE: September 13, 2016

Under the *Natural Products Marketing Act*, R.S.P.E.I., 1988, Cap. N-3, the Chicken Farmers of Prince Edward Island (formerly Poultry Meat Commodity Marketing Board) Marketing Regulations and the Prince Edward Island Chicken Order made pursuant to the *Agricultural Products Marketing Act* (Canada), the Chicken Farmers of Prince Edward Island makes the following Order:

CHICKEN QUOTA ORDER

1. This Order applies to the control and regulation of the production and marketing of chicken in the Province of Prince Edward Island.
2. (1) The meaning of words herein shall be as defined herein or, if not defined, as in the *Natural Products Marketing Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. N -3 and the Chicken Farmers of Prince Edward Island Chicken Farmers Marketing Regulations.
- (2) In this order:
 - a) “CFC” means the Chicken Farmers of Canada formed under the *Farm Products Agencies Act* (Canada).
 - b) “Board” means the Chicken Farmers of Prince Edward Island;
 - c) “Chicken” means a chicken of any class or parts thereof produced in the Province of Prince Edward Island, but does not include a chicken that is;
 - I. Five months or older,
 - II. Ten days or younger, or
 - III. Used in egg production;
 - d) “Processor” means any person engaged in the slaughtering of chicken.
 - e) “Producer” means any person who raises chicken for processing, for sale to the public, or for use in products manufactured by him;

- f) "Basic Production Quota" means a quota allocated by the Board to a producer in terms of kilograms of eviscerated and/or live poultry meat to be utilised by the Board as a base for annual and/or periodic quota allocations to producers.
3. A producer who produces and markets poultry meat from less than 500 chickens in a calendar year is exempt from this order.
 4. Quota is the property of the Board.
 5. Quota is not only a restriction on the amount to be produced, but is also a commitment by the quota holder to produce.
 6. (a) Quota will be issued in the name of an individual.

(b) Where facilities are owned by a limited company, quota will be issued to an individual nominated by the company.
 7. Facilities used to produce the quota shall be registered with the Board.
 8. Licenses to market under a quota will be issued on an annual and/or periodic basis, both of which may be varied depending on the provincial allocation received from the Chicken Farmers of Canada (CFC).
 9. Over production shall be subject to the penalties established by the Board and CFC from time to time. Such penalties may include a reduction in quota or license for the next calendar year and/or monetary penalties.
 10. No penalty shall apply for over or under production in any one marketing period, provided that the production for the periodic allocation is within the quota or license issued.
 11. If the producer fails to produce 95% of their quota or license within a periodic allocation the Board may transfer the unused portion of their quota to other applicants unless reasonable cause for such production can be established to the satisfaction of the Board.
 12. The maximum quota that may be held by an individual producer is set at 750,000 kilograms eviscerated, or 1,020,408 kilograms live weight.
 13. Quota or license may be withheld or revoked by the Board for failure to pay provincial or CFC levies, or for failure to comply with the Act or Regulations.
 14. The conversion from live weight to eviscerated weight shall be as established by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada unless actual weights are available.
 15. (1) Producers and new producers applying for quota must satisfy the Board that they have, or will have within a reasonable period of time;
 - a) Suitable facilities
 - b) Adequate financial arrangements; and
 - c) An assured market

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- (2) Producers and/or new producers will not be considered if they have outstanding indebtedness with the Board for service charges, overproduction penalties, or levies payable to the Board, or;
 - (3) Producers and/or new producers will not be considered if they have contravened the Act, the Plan or an Order or direction of the Board.
16. (1) No person shall maintain or place chicken for market in excess of 500 chicken placement per year without having first received a quota from the board.
- (2) No producer shall produce chicken in excess of the quota issued to them in a given calendar year.
17. (1) Subject to assessment of an over marketing levy by Chicken Farmers of Canada, the Board may impose a levy on a producer who produces in excess of 102% of allocated production.
- (2) The over marketing levy assessed by the Board will be \$0.44 per kilogram, live weight on production between 102% and 104% of allocation and \$0.88 per kilogram, live weight of production in excess of 104% of allotted production.
18. Board Order PMCMB07-01 is hereby revoked.
19. This order is effective September 13th, 2016

BOARD ORDER: CFPEI 16-03
EFFECTIVE: September 13, 2016

Under the *Natural Products Marketing Act*, R.S.P.E.I., 1988, Cap. N-3, the Chicken Farmers of Prince Edward Island Marketing Regulations and the Prince Edward Island Chicken Order made pursuant to the *Agricultural Products Marketing Act* (Canada), R.S.C., 1985, C. A-6 the Chicken Farmers of Prince Edward Island makes the following Order:

CHICKEN QUOTA LEASING

1. This Order applies to the control and regulation of the leasing of marketing quota of chicken in the Province of Prince Edward Island.
2. (1) The meaning of words herein shall be as defined herein or, if not defined, as in the *Natural Products Marketing Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. N -3 and the Chicken Farmers of Prince Edward Island Chicken Farmers Marketing Regulations.

(2) In this order:
 - a) “Act” means the *Natural Products Marketing Act*. R.S.P.E.I., 1988, Cap. N-3 and or the *Agricultural Products Marketing Act* (Canada), R.S.C. 1985, C. A-6.
 - b) “Board” means the Chicken Farmers of Prince Edward Island;
 - c) “CFC” means the Chicken Farmers of Canada formed under the *Farm Products Agencies Act* (Canada).
 - d) “Chicken” means a chicken of any class or parts thereof produced in the Province of Prince Edward Island, but does not include a chicken that is;
 - I. Five months or older,
 - II. Ten days or younger, or
 - III. Used in egg production;
 - e) “Lessee” means a registered producer in Prince Edward Island, who after Board approval, will lease in a designated portion of their quota;
 - f) “Lessor” means a registered producer in Prince Edward Island, who after Board approval, will lease out the designated quota from a lessee.
 - g) “Plan means the Prince Edward Island Poultry Meat Commodity Marketing Regulations.
3. A registered producer of Prince Edward Island may, with the prior written authorisation of the Chicken Farmers of Prince Edward Island, lease up to 35% of their marketing quota to another registered producer of Prince Edward Island subject to the following:
 - a) A lease application must be made on the basis of kilograms of live chicken to be produced in a given production period.
 - b) Must be submitted to the Board prior to the start of the period.

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- c) Both lessor and the lessee involved must have cycles within the same period.
4. Any application to lease quota must be;
- a) Made by the proposed lessor;
 - b) Endorsed by the proposed lessee;
 - c) In the form contained herein;
5. The Board shall not grant an authorisation if;
- a) The proposed lessor or proposed lessee has outstanding indebtedness with the Board for service charges, overproduction penalties or levies payable to the Board.
 - b) The proposed lessee would exceed the base quota limit established by these regulations.
 - c) The proposed lessee or lessor has contravened the Act, the Plan or an Order or direction of the Board.
6. Each lease agreement must be for a specified period of time. The authorisation to lease is valid and continuing until the occurrence of the first of one of the following events;
- a) The time period set out in the lease has expired.
 - b) The Board receives a written request from both the lessor and the lessee to terminate the lease agreement.
 - c) The Board withdraws its approval of the lease because the lessor or lessee has contravened the Act, the Plan, or Board Orders made under the Act.
7. As long as the lease is in effect;
- a) The lessor's marketing quota allocation is reduced by the amount of the quota that is leased, and the lessee's marketing quota is increased by the same amount.
 - b) All Board Orders shall be applied based on the lessor's and the lessee's adjusted marketing quota allocation.
8. No subleasing of the leased quota shall be permitted.
9. Special circumstances will be considered on a case by case basis.
10. This order is effective September 13th, 2016.

Under the *Natural Products Marketing Act*, R.S.P.E.I., 1988, Cap. N-3, the Chicken Farmers of Prince Edward Island (formerly Poultry Meat Commodity Marketing Board) Marketing Regulations and the Prince Edward Island Chicken Order made pursuant to the *Agricultural Products Marketing Act* (Canada), the Chicken Farmers of Prince Edward Island makes the following Order:

INFORMATION ORDER

This Order applies to information required by the Board with respect to the control and regulation of the production and marketing of chicken in the Province of Prince Edward Island.

1. (1) The meaning of words herein shall be as defined herein or, if not defined, as in the *Natural Products Marketing Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. N -3 and the Chicken Farmers of Prince Edward Island Chicken Farmers Marketing Regulations.
- (2) In this order:
 - a) “Board” means the Chicken Farmers of Prince Edward Island;
 - b) “Chick” means a bird that is ten days or younger that will be raised as a chicken.
 - c) “Chicken” means a chicken of any class or parts thereof produced in the Province of Prince Edward Island, but does not include a chicken that is;
 - I. Five months or older,
 - II. Ten days or younger, or
 - III. Used in egg production;
 - d) “Processor” means any person engaged in the slaughtering of chicken.
 - e) “Producer” means any person who raises chicken for processing, for sale to the public, or for use in products manufactured by him;
 - f) “Hatchery” means any place, building, or premises where eggs used in the production of chicken are hatched.
 - g) “Reseller” means a person who hatches chicks or purchases chicks from a hatchery and sells the chicks to another person.
2. (1). Every person engaged in the production or marketing of chicken shall upon request, furnish to the Board any information relating to the production or marketing of chicken by them and shall make specific answers to any questions submitted to them by any member or employee of the Board or any individual duly authorised by the Board.
- (2) Every person engaged in the production or marketing of chicken shall permit any person authorised by the Board to inspect all books, records and premises of such person as it relates to the production and marketing of chicken.

3. Every hatchery or reseller who supplies chicks in Prince Edward Island shall provide the Board with the number of chicks supplied, the date the chicks were delivered and the name of the person to whom the chicks were delivered within 10 working days of sale/delivery.
4. Board Order PMCMB07-02 dated November 23, 2007 is hereby revoked.
5. This Order shall be effective on October 14th, 2016.
