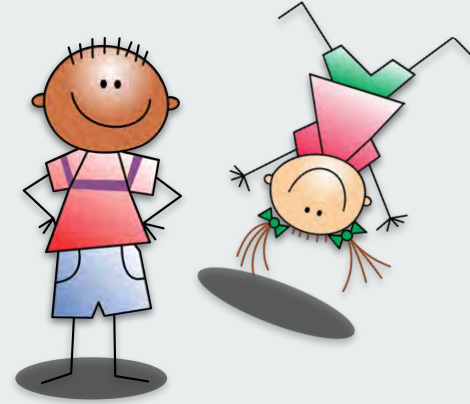


Passion, Create, Reflect
