Investments to ensure Islanders have access to the right services, at the right time, and in the right places now and in the future.

NEW/ENHANCED INVESTMENTS

Ventilation Upgrades

\$7.5M

This new investment will see ventilation systems upgraded across the remaining 10 Island schools, so that all schools have mechanical ventilation.

Childhood Recreation Fund

The Province will create a new childhood recreation fund to upgrade playground equipment across Island schools, through partnering with community groups.

School Construction and Renovations

\$105.8M

The Province will support planning for expansion at École François-Buote and continued investments at École Évangéline, continued construction for new Sherwood Elementary and new Stratford High School, and further renovations at Elliot River and Montague Schools.





Kings County Memorial Hospital Re-Development

\$13.3M

In 2022/2023, planning will begin for a new Kings County Memorial Hospital that will expand the current offerings of service to address future health care needs in the region.

Medical Homes and Neighborhoods

\$63.6N

Capital Budget 2022/2023 will introduce a new Community Health Centre (Medical Home) in Queens County, an additional investment of \$3.5M to existing spaces in Queens County, an increased investment in Summerside by \$13.6M to build and house a new Community Health Centre, as well as a new Community Health Centres in Western and Eastern PEI.

Mental Health

\$149.4M

Islanders mental health is equally important to their physical health, and Government is continuing our commitment to develop, modernize, and create sustainable mental health services on PEI. Construction has commenced on the first two facilities of the Mental Health Campus.



Healthcare IT

\$5.1M

This investment in information technology infrastructure that will support and improve community mental health and addiction services, support patient care and treatment of women during labour and delivery, and overall patient care.
